



## **BYC BOAT YARD POLICY**

**Purpose:** The BYC boatyard is intended to provide the membership access in pursuit of recreation upon the Bay. It is not intended as a place to store inactive boats. In that spirit, boats that are not used or infrequently used may be considered inactive and may not be accommodated within the boatyard during the upcoming season. This will be at the discretion of the Board with input from the club manager. Because of the current lack of space in the boatyard, the following policies have been implemented in the boatyard.

### **Definition:**

- Active boat: a boat that is used at least five times during the season.
- Inactive boat: a boat that is used less than five times during the season.

**Identity:** All boats stored in the boatyard must have a current BYC sticker issued by the Manager with the member's name on the stern.

**Storage:** Placement of boats is based on consideration of all members and the ease of movement of boats within the Boatyard.

- All boats must be on a moveable trailer or dolly. Trailers & Dollies must be clearly labeled with the member's name.
- Boats larger than 23 feet or heavier than 1900 pounds are not permitted to be stored on trailers on the club grounds except as permitted by extreme circumstances, (ie, emergency haul out, etc) with permission of the Board.
- Boats used in BYC sailing lessons may be stored in the lift area.
- There are 14 parking spaces – beginning with #1 to the South and terminating with #14 to the North - along the East side of the Boatyard in front of the lockers and are assigned by the House/Sailing Committee. There is a waiting list for spaces which is maintained by the Club Manager on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The central portion of the boatyard is designated for small boats 16 feet or less on dollies only. Trailered boats may not be store in this area.

**Payment:** For 2009 parking spaces must be paid for within 5 days of the boat entering the boatyard. If payment is not received by the above date, available spaces will be given to the next person on the waiting list. Any spaces that remain unoccupied by July 10<sup>th</sup> revert to the Club and will be reassigned.

**Vacant:** If a situation arises which prevents a member from utilizing their assigned space by July 10<sup>th</sup>, they must notify the Sailing Chair in writing before July 10<sup>th</sup> stating the reasons why. The Sailing Chair will bring the issue before the Board which may elect to take this into consideration.

## POLICY AND PROCEDURE –BOAT YARD

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**PWC:** Personal Watercraft (PWC) are not permitted to be stored on BYC property but members may utilize the boatyard to launch and retrieve only. Tow vehicle & trailer must park out of property when not being used.

**Trailers:** Empty trailers are not to be stored on BYC property.

**Abandoned:** Abandoned boats, trailers and equipment will be dealt with by the Sailing Chairperson and the Board at their discretion.

**Launch Ramp:** The launch ramp is for the exclusive use of the members only. Non-members are not permitted to use the ramp.

### **Floating Dock**

The floating docks are to be used primarily for lessons, boat loading and unloading, and temporary tie-up. Consideration of fellow club members should be made at all times.
