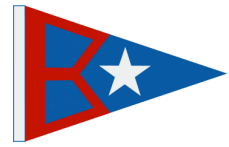


# **BABYLON YACHT CLUB**

## **POLICY AND PROCEDURE – HOUSE, POOL AND GUEST RULES**

---



### **BYC HOUSE, POOL AND GUEST RULES**

#### **House Rules**

- Hours of operation will be established by the House Committee and posted in the Clubhouse. Hours throughout the season will vary based on climate and usage.
- Persons in bathing suits are not permitted in the Clubhouse. Unattended children under 18 years of age are not permitted in the Clubhouse. Children under 18 years of age are not permitted on the upper floor of the Clubhouse.
- Members and guests must be properly attired when attending a social function in the Clubhouse. Gentlemen shall wear jackets unless the function has previously been designated as casual.
- Members should expect and efficient and courteous response from the Club staff. Members are not to reprimand any employee, but are encouraged to submit any complaint or comment regarding any employee to the House Committee Chairman or the Secretary.
- Children of members and guest shall be properly attended whenever on Club premises. BYC assumes no responsibility for their safety.
- The restrooms in the main Clubhouse are for the use of adult members and guests. Children are to use the restrooms located in the bathhouse area. All persons shall use the bathhouse facilities for changing swimsuits, diapers, clothing, etc.
- The Club will not be responsible for loss or damage to personal property of members or their guests, or for damage to any vessel docked at the Club or stored on its grounds.
- Property of the Club, or in its possession, shall not be taken from the Club grounds. Such property removed, damaged or destroyed by a member, his or her family, or guest, shall be paid for promptly by such member.
- Club staff shall not be sent off Club premises for any purpose, except on official duty.
- Dogs are not permitted on the Club grounds.
- Boats left at the dock overnight shall be securely fastened and not left for more than 72 hours. Hoses, lines, coolers, PFD's, fishing equipment, etc. are not to be left lying on the dock unattended.
- Comments and/or complaints shall be directed to the Secretary or the House Committee Chairman. No verbal complaints shall be entertained unless an emergency condition exists.
- There shall be no swimming off the club docks other than in a supervised Club activity.

#### **Guest Rules**

- Members are encouraged to exercise their guest privileges. Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests.

- A member may bring a non-member to the Club as a guest, but the same person – whether adult or child – shall not be a guest, either of the same member or of different members, on more than four occasions during one season.
- No more than twelve guests (eight on the weekends) can be entertained at the Club by a member at one time without prior Board approval. This rule applies to the gathering regardless of the number of members at the gathering.
- Guests are permitted only when accompanied by a member or one of the member's family who is over the age of sixteen.
- Guest cards may be obtained for house guest of members visiting the community for a limited period. Guest cards may be obtained from the House Committee and are subject at all times to withdrawal or cancellation.

### **Pool Regulations**

- Members must sign the pool register on a daily basis upon entering the pool enclosure. Guests must be signed in by name as well. Pool guest fees in the amount of \$5.00 per guest, per day, shall be collected upon signing in.
- Non-swimmers are not allowed in the main pool unless accompanied into the pool by an adult. Ability to swim shall be determined conclusively by the senior lifeguard on duty.
- All persons entering the pool must shower. All persons using sun lotions, ointments, etc. must shower before re-entering the pool. Persons with obvious skin infections, lacerations, etc. or requiring exterior bandages will not be permitted in the pool.
- Swimming devices such as face masks, flippers, life jackets and floats are prohibited unless part of BYC swim instructions.
- Strollers, carriages, beverages and food are not permitted within the pool enclosure.
- Lounge chairs are available for adult members and their adult guests. These lounges are available on a first come, first served basis, and may not be reserved. Children may use lounges when not required by adults.
- The wading pool is reserved for non-swimmers who must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
- No person under 18 years of age may use the pool after 5:30p.m. unless accompanied by an adult member who remains on the Club premises.
- The pool will be restricted to adult use periodically during each day at the discretion of the senior lifeguard.
- All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The Club assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

Policy and the list of regulations have been worked out by the Pool Operations Committee and approved by the Board of Governors. They are based upon close working knowledge of our Club and the experience of other pools. The rules are expected to change from time to time as the Committee profits from its own experience. Club members will be notified as additions and revisions are necessary. Parents, their children, and guests are urged to learn and observe the rules.

### **Supervision of the Pool**

The Pool Director, under the supervision of the Club Manager, is responsible for the operation of the pool and enforcement of the rules and regulations.

### **Signing Register**

Members and/or guests must sign the pool register on a daily basis upon entry to into the pool enclosure.

### **Disciplinary Action**

The pool is maintained for the safety and pleasure of all members. Use of the pool and infractions of the rules will lead to disciplinary action or suspension of pool privileges.

### **Responsibility for Injury**

All persons using the pool do so at their own risk; the Babylon Yacht Club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.
