1. Venue:

1.1 The venue will be off the Babylon Yacht Club in the general area of Babylon and West Islip, NY.

3. Eligibility: This is an invitational event.

4. Entries: Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form to the Registration Desk between 0830-1000 daily on the Babylon Yacht Club Porch

5. Rules:

5.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (*RRS*).

5.2 Conflicts between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions it will be resolved in favor of the Sailing Instructions. This changes *RRS* rule 63.7.

6. Safety: USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by One Design competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed. This modifies *RRS* 40.1 and preamble to Part 4. All competitors must supply their own PFDs.

7. Scoring: The Low-Point Scoring System, *RSS* Appendix A2 will apply except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

8. Course: The One Design courses will be triangles, windward/leeward or a combination thereof. PHRF courses will be a combination of government marks and inflatable marks. All courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded after Sunday's races on the BYC porch.

10. Berthing: Available at the BYC Dock or Launch areas on a first-come-first-serve basis.

11. Food: Box Lunches will be sold at the Club House on Saturday. Division 1 (except PHRF) & Division 2 can be pre-order lunches, at the registration desk, for water delivery. Approximately 45 minutes will be allocated for lunch.
